## **GUIDELINES**

This grant is intended to fund expenses for <u>adult students</u> seeking to improve their reading, writing, numeracy skills, or English language proficiency. To be approved, grant proposals must have an academic-based focus that assists adults to become literate and obtain the knowledge and skills necessary to reach their goals. READ Pinellas approves funding requests that cannot be met through the regular agency or organizational budgets due to lack of adequate funds, budgetary prohibitions, or types of expenditures, etc. **Reimbursement** will be based on submitted receipts and disbursed to mini-grant applicants only. Approved applications will require an **End of Project Report** to be submitted within 30 days of the end of the project or by May 2, 2025, whichever comes first. Applications are subject to board approval and availability of funds. **Mini-grants can only be submitted during the following time periods:** 

Submission Dates: August 6<sup>th</sup> to September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024 November 1<sup>st</sup> to November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024 February 3<sup>rd</sup> to February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025

To apply for this mini-grant, you must be a current member of READ Pinellas (fiscal year is 7/1 - 6/30). Members may submit more than one mini-grant during a calendar year, as long as the total expenditures do not exceed \$500 (unless otherwise noted below).
